FAQs

Who will screen these guests?

Trained screeners will perform intake and background checks for each woman. Nightly security checks and house rules are **strictly** enforced. If a guest violates the rules, or has 2 unexcused no-shows, she loses her spot.

How will volunteers stay safe?

Volunteers will be trained in communication and safety methods. In addition, Asbury Park and Neptune Police will have a list of host churches.

What happens after they leave?

Our main concern is emergency nightly housing. We will coordinate case management, referral and systems advocacy with social services and health agencies to help guests re-establish a normal life.

Why do you need money?

Donated funds will be used for food and personal items for our guests and overhead. This includes cots, pillows, blankets, outreach costs and insurance.

About WHN



The Women’s Hospitality Network (WHN) is a collaborative effort of houses of worship, organizations, and individuals from the greater Asbury Park and Neptune areas and beyond. Together, they work to provide emergency, night-time housing from December through March for single women that are experiencing homelessness.

It is a matter of justice, not simply charity.

WHN is modeled after the program established by the Freehold Clergy Association (FCA) in New Jersey and other successful national programs. The FCA has provided a similar service over the past thirteen winters for single men experiencing homelessness.

Several churches in the Asbury Park and Neptune areas have joined the call to action in providing this service to the community.

We also collaborate with local police departments, healthcare providers and social service agencies.

Organizations Involved



Local churches, organizations, companies, and individuals provide support for the Network. This includes overnight space and volunteers, some financial support, meals and personal items needed.

With your participation, the less effort it will take on the part of everyone involved. Let’s add your name to this growing list.
